In this activity, you'll answer a series of questions about "A Superhero of the Sea" that will help you think more deeply about how dolphins have been endangered by harmful fishing practices and "swim-with" aquarium shows. - 4. What is currently one of the fastest-growing threats to dolphins? What are two misperceptions that lead people to believe that dolphins are happy in captivity?**
