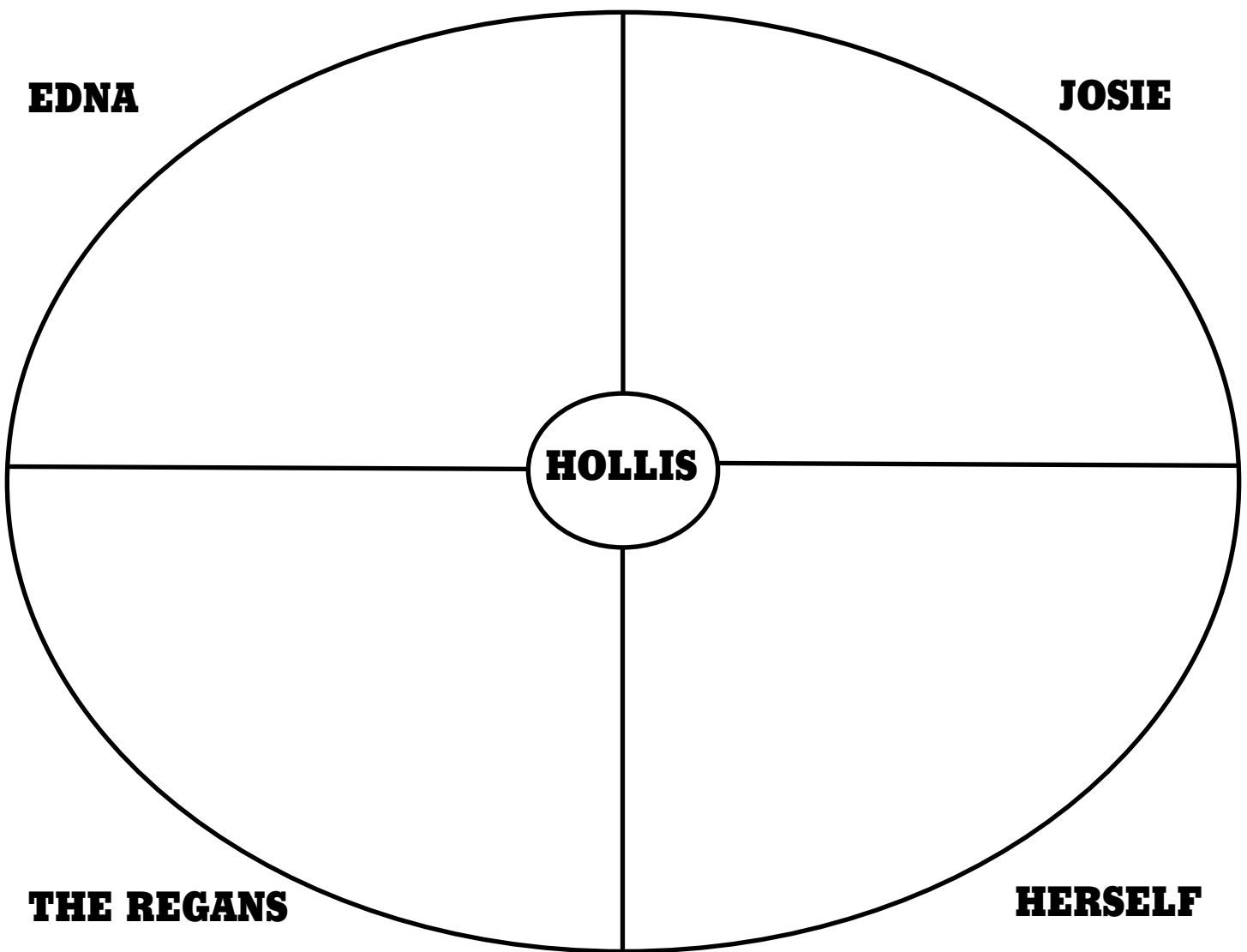


# Making Connections
