

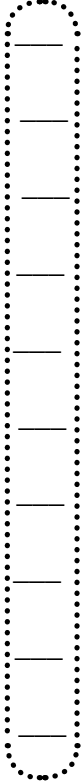
The *Hindenburg* Dictionary
